



**Resolution adopted by the United Nations Human Rights Council
on 3rd October 2025
on the topic of
Safeguarding Human Rights in the region of Nagorno-Karabakh**

The United Nations Human Rights Council,

*Guided by the 1948 Universal Declaration of Human Rights, the fundamental basis of
international law,*

*Deeply disturbed by the pain and suffering of the innocent, of the displaced refugees and the
separated families,*

Having devoted attention to ensuring safety of innocent, children and elders,

*Desiring to ensure safety of civilians and respect for human rights in the region, that has
witnessed bloodshed for over 37 years,*

Emphasizing the need for humanitarian aid for those, who have lost everything,

Seeking stability in land devastated by war,

1. *Requests* the United Nations Security Council to negotiate the issue of peacekeeping and control of the flow of humanitarian aid into the region of Nagorno-Karabakh, in order to:
 - a. satisfy the concerns of the Republic of Azerbaijan regarding the issue of weapon smuggling actions being taken,
 - b. ensure safety of civilians entering, exiting and transiting through the region of Nagorno-Karabakh, via:
 - i. setting up information systems aimed to optimize the flow of information and ensuring effectiveness of border control,
 - ii. subsiding the tensions arising between refugees and personnel or other refugees,
 - iii. bringing immediate aid in case of any sudden accidents during the process of border control,
 - iv. Establish periodical caravan escorts equipped with GPS systems, under the protection of respective peacekeepers;
2. *Requests* an OHCHR mission, supervised by respective governmental organs, to create an independent and objective source of information in form of annual reports on the humanitarian situation in the region of Nagorno-Karabakh, for the members of the United Nations and to support the nation of Azerbaijan and Armenia in fulfilling their obligations regarding human rights;
3. *Suggests* the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Republic of Georgia to establish humanitarian corridors through the territory of the Republic of Georgia, permitting humanitarian aid to enter the region.
4. *Requests* the International Criminal Court to investigate, the Republics of Azerbaijan and Armenia in order to hold accountable those responsible for crimes against humanity in the region of Nagorno-Karabakh:

- a. under the supervision of respective governmental officials,
 - b. including a delegation of respective governmental officials to assist the Office of the Prosecutor of the ICC in the investigation;
5. *Further encourages* the members of the United Nations to assist and cooperate with humanitarian organizations such as the International Committee of the Red Cross, the CARE International and the UN World Food Program (WFP) while they provide aid to the civilians in the region;
6. *Requests upon* the United Nations Economic and Social Council to establish economical support to the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Republic of Armenia, for the purpose of:
 - a. rebuilding the amenities of utmost urgency for the residents of the region,
 - b. ensuring economic stability for the region to fully recover and become integral part of the Republic of Azerbaijan;
7. *Request* establishing a plan for displaced people from Nagorno-Karabakh to Armenia or other UN States:
 - a. ensuring their accommodation and protection of their human rights,
 - b. supporting their voluntary right to return, including:
 - i. safe travel,
 - ii. resettlement options;
8. *Requests* developing and implementing national policies in order to take equal care of every single civilian in the region of Nagorno-Karabakh:
 - a. ensuring equal rights as stated in the 1948 Universal Declaration of Human Rights and regional laws,
 - b. ensuring equal treatment of every citizen of the region, with an emphasis on equality compared to other regions under the protection of the government of the Republic of Azerbaijan,

- c. ensuring, that equal rights are awarded to those who employ their right to return;
9. *Calls* for protection and restoration of cultural heritage and property entitlements in the region of Nagorno-Karabakh, by:
- a. recreating places of worship such as chapels, churches and religious monuments,
 - b. ensuring safety of historical and cultural values and heritage by recreating cultural infrastructure such as theaters, museums and monuments;
 - c. protecting the property rights of the Karabakh citizens who have migrated from the region.
10. *Calls* for establishing the Nagorno-Karabakh Advisory Fund Commission (NKAFC) intended to create a fund for the people of Nagorno-Karabakh, while:
- a. calling upon the members of the UN to join the NKAFC as commission members,
 - b. suggesting the main purposes of the fund:
 - i. establishment of a system of compensations for the victims of the humanitarian crisis,
 - ii. funding the humanitarian aid entering the region,
 - c. leaving the specification of the amount of funding to be received from every member of the commission to the NKAFC;
11. *Remains* actively seized of the matter.
